Benneville mustered into Company D of the 143rd Pennsylvania Infantry. He was killed at the Battle of Laurel Hill, Virginia. The Certificate of Death, issued by the Army of the Potomac stated, in five words as follows: 'was killed by a bullet'. His pay chit noted that he was indebted to the U. S. for \$19.00 on account of extra clothing drawn from stores. Due him, however was \$75.00 U. S. Bounty and two months pay at \$13 and \$16 each, the latter prorated to date of death for a total of \$30.12. It may be of interest that his pay records spell his first name as Benowill (if you are familiar with the spoken German dialect where v's are pronounced as 'w' it is probably a phonetic spelling of Benneville). Two casualty sheets listed Benneville's death. One listed his name as B. Heiffer, the other as Benowil Keffner.

Heffner was extracted from his military, pension and medical records received from the National Archives and from affidavits attached to those records. Augustus S. Heffner was mustered into the 167th Pennsylvania Regiment, Company C on November 12, 1862 at Reading, Pa. as a Private soldier. A note attached to his military record shows that he was admitted to hospital on July 12, 1863 and was assigned to Ward 9, bed #25 suffering from Remittent Fever. He returned to duty on August 7, 1863. The report notes that he was then 30 years of age. Augustus was mustered out of the service August 11, 1863 at Reading, Pa. At his mustering out he received an advance of \$36.29. Augustus died of Small Pox on October 22, 1876. A near neighbor, Benjamin Hafer, of Oley, aged 84 assisted in his burial, helping to put him in his coffin. The attending physician was Dr. J. A. Jack, the undertaker was U. H. Schlegel, also of Oley. On November 11, 1890, his wife Elizabeth Yerger Heffner filed for his soldier's pension. Elizabeth could not write but instead signed the claim with her mark (X). It was witnessed by two persons: Sallie C. Kaufman and Hannah Kaufman before the Justice of the Peace Frank Y. Kaufman, of Oley, Berks County, Pa. There are a number of affidavits attached to his records that speak for Elizabeth to wit: The personal property of Elizabeth was worth about \$160.00. Real estate was worth about \$1300, of which about \$700 was encumbered. Henry Yerger and another witness, Henry Fry claimed that Elizabeth supported herself by farming and trucking on a small piece of land and that she had little furniture and some farming implements. Nowhere in the records is there any mention of children. It is assumed that Augustus and Elizabeth had none. Note that his military record carries his middle initial as 'S'.

It doesn't state whether he was sick or injured. He was born at Minersville, Pa. about 1842 according to his Service Record. The only other document I have on him is in the 1871-1872 Northumberland Borough Tax Books, where he is listed as butcher, for occupation. He is interred over at Norry in the Riverview Cemetery about 100 yards from his younger sister, Henrietta Heffner Johnson. The cemetery has no record of his interment. His headstone is of the small military type and inscribed B.F. Heffner, Co. I, 58th Inf." He later drowned in Chillisquaque Creek. Clara: Clara was buried in Riverview Cemetery, Northumberland, Northumberland Co., Pa.
