Notes from Probate Court, Lima Ohio, Allen County

Eveline Bennett, Jacobs daughter, married Alpheus Adams in Allen County on February 27, 1861 (Book A - Pg. 366)

Sarah Bennett & James Cunningham married in Allen County on August 11, 1863. Is this our Sarah Bennett? Not enough information on marriage license to verify. (Book B, Pg. 3)

Checked Marriage license records for:

William Bennett & Phebe Hochstetler (Book A, Pg 355)

John L. Roberts & Nancy Bennett (Book A, pg 83)

They are the same license, we already have.

Louisa Decker & Joseph Bennett, married in Allen County, on July 7, 1864. Louisa was on the 1860 Allen County Census with Jacob & Barbara Bennett. Is Louisa, Barbara's daughter by a previous marriage? and who was Joseph Bennett? Jacobs nephew?? (Book B - pg. 50)

Phelanda Bennett, Jacobs daughter, married Daniel Fair in Allen County, on October 30, 1873. (Book C-1, pg 209)

Ida Bennett, William's daughter, married Thomas Rupert, in Allen County, on February 1, 1888 (Book E, pg 65)
